Hello again. We have received responses from our 8th grade and 8th grade PSR, and our numbers are good. We have 34 students and approximately 21 chaperones confirmed on our trip. We can travel with a total of 56 people. Currently, with the number of people we have attending the Prolife Trip we are still within our estimated budget of \$250 per person. Our hope is to raise enough money to keep the students cost at \$175.00.

I am enclosing for you an envelope for our Miller's Grill Fundraiser November 28, 2010. I enclosed 10 tickets for each student to sell. Please work hard and try to sell all 10 tickets. This can be a very good fundraiser if we put a little effort into selling the tickets. The cost of the breakfast is \$6 and the breakfast begins at 8am and ends at 10am. We will be serving Eggs, French Toast, Bacon, Coffee, Juice and Milk. Tickets will also be sold the day of the event at the door. I have received several responses from parents and students who will be able to work the breakfast. If you have not responded please let me know if you are available to help on November 28th. We will need to be at Millers Grill on November 28th no later than 7:30am and we should be finished by 11 am.

I will need to have the money for the tickets sold on Friday November 20th, so we can give an estimate to Miller's Grill. If you need more tickets please let me know and I will see that you get more tickets. Please turn in any unsold tickets on Friday November 20th with your money.
